# Grades

Grades for all of Mrs. Johnson's music classes:

25% Playing posture, technique and competency.

25% Tests and in-class activities.

25% Musicianship- includes behavior and attitude.

## Concert Dates

Concerts attendance is required to receive an "A" in this class. No excuses, no makeups allowed. Sporting events, family vacation, etc are unexcused. Family emergencies will be considered on a case by case basis.

## Concert Clothing

Students need to wear white shirts, black slacks or skirts and black shoes. Boys are encouraged to wear ties of any color.

## Cell Phone and iPod policy

iPods and MP3 players are not allowed on campus in any way and will be immediately confiscated. Cell phones may be used outside of class time. Students discovered texting in class will have their cell phones confiscated.

## Mrs. Johnson's Music discipline policy
